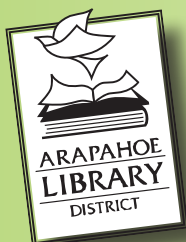
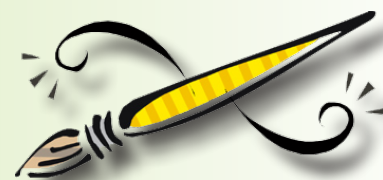




Smoky Hill Library invites teen artists to submit finished work (any work done in the past year) for an Art Contest. Winners' artwork will be displayed in the library during November 2009.

Dates to Remember:

- Date library will begin accepting entries: Thursday, October 1
- Deadline for submittal: 3 p.m., Saturday, October 24
- Notification of accepted work: Monday, October 26
- Accepted work delivered to the library: Friday, October 30 and Saturday, October 31
- Opening Reception and Awards: Thursday, November 5
- Pick up work: Saturday, November 28 and Sunday, November 29

How to Submit:

1. Online - quick and easy - send us digital images of your work. Include title, medium, size and date of work. To send work online, address your e-mail to kandrews@ald.lib.co.us. Please type "Teen Art Submission" in the subject field. Make sure to include your contact information in the e-mail, including your name, phone number, e-mail and home address.
2. Bring in slides, pictures or a CD of artwork to Smoky Hill Library, 5430 S. Biscay Circle (NE corner of Smoky Hill Road and Biscay, one block east of Tower Road). Please mark your work with your name, phone number, e-mail and home address.
3. **Bring actual work in on Saturday, October 24** to Smoky Hill Library, 5430 S. Biscay Circle (NE corner of Smoky Hill Road and Biscay, one block east of Tower Road). Make sure that it is properly protected. Please mark all pieces with your name, phone number, e-mail and home address.

Rules:

- Accepted mediums: works on paper, works on canvas*, jewelry and smaller three-dimensional works.**
**Works on canvas do not have to be framed but the edges must be finished.*
***Sculpture will be limited to the size of our display cases, roughly 18" high, 18" deep, 18" wide.*
- No more than three submittals per teen.
- All accepted work must be matted and framed unless otherwise arranged with gallery coordinators.
- All work needs to be labeled with title, dimensions, medium, artist name and contact information.
- Open to teens in grades 6 through 12.
